

Blueberry French Toast Bake

¼ cup whole wheat flour
¼ cup all-purpose flour
1½ cups skim milk
1 tablespoon sugar
½ teaspoon vanilla
¼ teaspoon salt

3 eggs 6 egg whites 1 loaf (12 ounces) French bread, cut into 1 inch cubes 3 ounces fat free cream cheese, cut into ½ inch cubes

Generously **grease** a 13x9x2-inch baking dish. **Beat** flours, milk, sugar, vanilla, salt, eggs and egg whites in a large mixing bowl with a hand mixer until smooth. **Stir** in bread cubes until they are coated. **Pour** bread mixture into baking dish. **Top** evenly with cream cheese, blueberries and almonds. **Cover** and **refrigerate** for at least 1 hour, but no longer than 24 1 **cup** fresh blueberries ½ **cup** chopped almonds Honey, if desired

hours. **Heat** oven to 400 degrees F. **Uncover** and **bake** 20-25 minutes or until golden brown. **Sprinkle** with honey, if desired.

Yield: 8, 1 cup servings
